THE SECOND WEEKEND OF FESTIVAL DU VOYAGEUR 2017 STARTS TONIGHT!

SAINT-BONIFACE, February 23, 2017 – Despite the melting snow, here's to all the HéHo Heroes who persevered and made Festival du Voyageur's « joie de vivre » burn all the brighter. It was a celebratory first weekend filled with memorable moments, good friends and that kind of warm welcoming atmosphere that only Festival du Voyageur can provide. This upcoming second weekend promises to be just as great. From February 23 to 26, expect excellent music, delicious eats and unique activities at Voyageur Park and our Official Sites.

"Festival du Voyageur would like to reassure festivalgoers that we are doing everything we can to ensure that our festival grounds are safe", said Ginette Lavack Walters, Executive Director of Festival du Voyageur. "With the cold weather coming back, Voyageur Park may be a bit icy. Our park crew is adding woodchips and sand to create safer passageways for our visitors. We also ask that festivalgoers use caution when walking on the festival grounds. Due to the abnormally mild weather, we expect strong attendance again this weekend and appreciate our patrons' patience as we do our utmost to effectively manage and control traffic on site by monitoring entry and exit flows."

PETIT CANADA AND A FRANCOPHONE BATTLE OF THE BANDS

This Thursday, February 23, Festival du Voyageur, in collaboration with the Conseil jeunesse provincial (CJP) will offer an evening of programming "by youth, for youth". This year marks the 22nd edition of the **Petit Canada** evening at Voyageur Park. This night will feature bands such as **Alfa Rococo**, **Les Respectables**, 2016 Radio-Canada Revelation **Laurence Nerbonne**, **Mamadou** and **The Mariachi Ghost** to name a few. The evening will also feature the **2017 Chicane Électrique**, an epic battle of the bands for local francophone artists presented by Le 100 Nons and the CJP. The competition will be held in the MTS Rivière-Rouge Tent from 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. Voyageur Park will be open to the public from 6 p.m. to 12 p.m.

A SECOND WEEKEND OF WOOD CARVING WITH CHAINSAWS

Festival du Voyageur in collaboration with the Winnipeg River Chainsaw Carving Association presents the first **Wood Carving Challenge** featuring chainsaw carvers from all over the nation including stars of **HGTV's Carver Kings** and **OLN's Sawdogs**. On February 25, our seven carvers attempt the **Quick Carve Challenge** in Voyageur Park starting at 10:30 a.m. Each carver will have only a few hours to carve a small unique and original sculpture.
